Upcoming MVBA November Election

With the November 20th MVBA Board Elections soon approaching, we are currently accepting nominations for serving on the MVBA Board. This election cycle has two (2) Director positions up for election.

Director (2 positions serving 3-year term)

Steve Shen & Open Director Position, Current Directors

The purpose and function of the Board of Directors of the Association shall be to provide advice and consent to the President in the day-to-day management of the Association's affairs.

Additional Responsibilities include:

- Meeting and acting as a board to adopt such rules and regulations for the conduct of meetings and management of the Association as are deemed proper, not inconsistent with the Articles of Incorporation and By-laws of the Association.
- Participate in the planning of the meetings of the Association and to prepare recommendations for the membership.
- Approve the expenditures funds by the officers of the Association and to adopt a budget for the Association each year;
- Receive an annual statement of income and expense and provide for its audit;
- Act on behalf of the issue(s) at a general meeting of the full membership.
- Executive such additional duties as may be required by the By-laws, as amended from time to time.

Again, a huge thanks is due to Kristin Speaker, for negotiating and arranging this wonderful and prominent ad placement.


July kicked off with Mount Vernon as the featured neighborhood within the Historic Charles Street Corridor.
