As always, our general meetings are free and open to the public, members and non-members alike. Please join us to discuss important issues and events related to our Mount Vernon community.



Open Discussion to Reduce Number of MVBA General Meetings

Over the last several months, the MVBA board has discussed the possibility of reducing the number of monthly meetings to a bi-monthly rotation (i.e. every other month).

As per the MVBA by-laws, we are bringing this idea to the General Membership for discussion. We want to hear your thoughts about this possible change.

Once we have had time to collectively think about this proposal, we will hold a formal vote at the July General Meeting, held on July 17th.

Currently, we meet the third Tuesday of every month, except for August and December. This proposal would reduce our meeting count from 10 a year to six. We believe that this would allow us to focus and structure the General Meetings to cover issues and topics in a more comprehensive forum, to be mindful of everyone's valuable time.
